2021 Institutive Plan

Bodrum Chamber of Commerce with 19.06.2018 date and 11 number board of management decision started the works of new term strategic plan.

As part of the strategic plan passes from the enstructured management system to “Institutive Management System” Bodrum Chamber of Commerce in January 2021 finished the TSE audit and in December 2019 finished the accreditation audit successfully. It is one of the class A accredited chambers and continues to use the TSE Dec ISO 9001: 2015 certificate in the system.

January 2021, due to the effects of the pandemic, BODTO continued its working system without interruption by performing flexible and remote work, the 1st TSE study conducted on September 30, 2021 with the supervision audit, it was decided to continue the TSE 9001: 2015 QMS certificate.

Our Chamber, which has renewed its TSE Safe Service Certificate with the audit conducted on October 01, 2021, continues to be institutionalized in its services.

In addition to the web page, it also strengthens the communication network with social media accounts. In 2014, 1.710 people started to follow our Twitter page, 1.788 people started following our Facebook page. In 2015, 1.926 people started to follow our Facebook page, 1.925 people started to follow our Twitter page. In 2016, 2.179 people started to follow our Facebook page and 2.047 people started our Twitter page. In 2017, 2.251 people started our Facebook page and 2.141 people started to follow our Twitter page. In 2018, this rates 2.428 on Facebook and 2.157 on Twitter. In 2019, while having 2.526 people on Facebook and 2.196 on Twitter, we opened an Instagram page and gained 132 followers. In the year 2020 our Facebook page had 2.605 followers and our Twitter page had 2.248 people meanwhile, our Instagram page had 603 followers. **In 2021, 2.643 people followed our Facebook page and 2.328 person in Twitter while in Instagram 1.050 person.**

In 2014, there were 7.203 people in our SMS system and 6.938 people in our mailing system. In the year 2015, SMS 7.503 and mailing were 7.238 in total. 91 data sets have been created. Research has been conducted on 12 different topics. 42 reports were made, 64 articles were written.

On the other hand, many laws which changed and laws that closely affect the business activities of our members and have been amended are investigated, a report is prepared and announced to the members.
